LENTEN FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Catechism of the Catholic Church : Number 2043 “The Fourth Precept” and “The Fifth Precept” of the Church.

ABSTINENCE – Abstinence means sacrificing meat in our meals. Regular meals are appropriate. Seafood is appropriate. This applies to all Catholics aged 15 years and over. Meals should reflect a “penitential spirit”.

FASTING – Fasting means there is no meat involved, seafood is acceptable, and only one meal in the day. Other food may be taken in the day as long as they do not equal another meal. This applies to Catholics ages 15 through 59 years old, however the abstinence rule applies as well.

Women’s Guild Scholarship, Starting April 1

Our Lady of Tahoe Women’s Guild, and through the generosity of one of our parishioners, are offering a Foundation Grant of \$5,000 per semester scholarship (payable for tuition only) to a 2020 graduating high school senior or an applicant who is an active, practicing Catholic and continuing education at the college level. Parishioners and students who are part of the extended family of Our Lady of Tahoe parishioners are eligible to apply. The scholarship is based on scholastic achievement and participation in spiritual activities within his/her community. A scholastic record of no grade lower than a B is necessary to obtain this scholarship. Our Lady of Tahoe Women’s Guild is also offering a \$2500 scholarship based on scholastic achievement and participation in spiritual activities within his/her community. A minimum GPA of 3.0 is necessary to apply for this scholarship. Applicants may pick up forms at the parish office during normal business hours (8:30 - 2:30, M-F). The deadline for submitting completed applications is Thursday, April 30th at 2pm. An electronic version of the application may also be requested from the office manager via email (susan@ourladyoftahoe.org) & on the subject line, please type in *Women’s Guild Scholarship Application Form*.
