



From Bishop Calvo:

We continue our efforts to instill in our communities and nation a true respect for the sanctity of life. As part of the variety of ways we can participate, I call to your attention the 40 Days for Life campaign, which has 3 key components: prayer and fasting, peaceful vigil, and nonconfrontational community outreach. This campaign will begin on Wednesday February 17 and end on Sunday, March 28. Importantly, this campaign runs during our fast-approaching season of Lent. Therefore, it provides an excellent opportunity to offer prayer and fasting for our Lord in support of "the least of these by brothers." (Matthew 25:40)

God often used the period of the 40 days in Sacred Scripture to indicate a time of prayer and penance when we turn closer to God. It is a time of conversion and change of heart. Through the 40 Days for Life, we pray there will be a transformation in the hearts of people in our community and country so that they will cherish and respect God's gift of life, and there will be an end to abortion. I encourage you to be a witness to the life of the unborn in our community by participating in the 40 Days for Life campaign, especially during this 2021 Lenten Season.
