The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

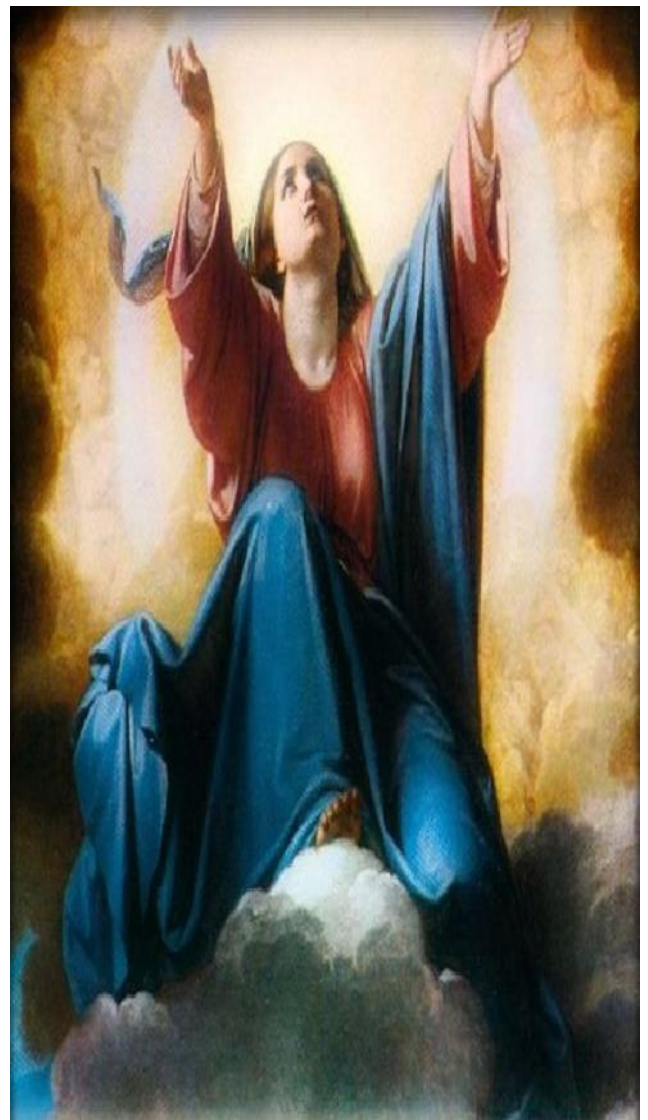
O how wondrous is the dignity of the glorious Virgin! She merited to become the mother of Him who is the strength and beauty of the angels and the grandeur of all the saints.

WHEN: Thursday nights September through May

Two levels, same fee:

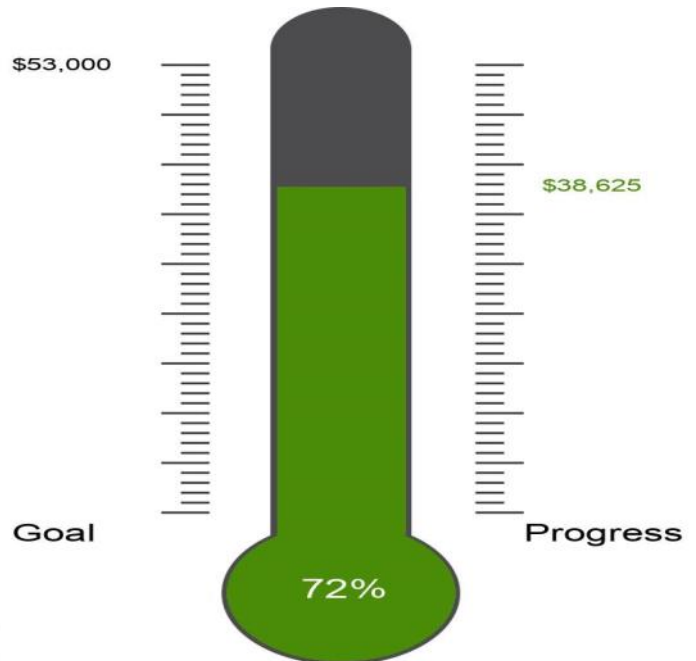
