Already, Tropical Storm Grace increased the misery of the people hurt by the earthquake. We also know that Haiti is one of the poorest nations in the world, and recently experienced political unrest as their leader was assassinated. OLT will take up a second special collection the weekend of September 25-26, 2021.

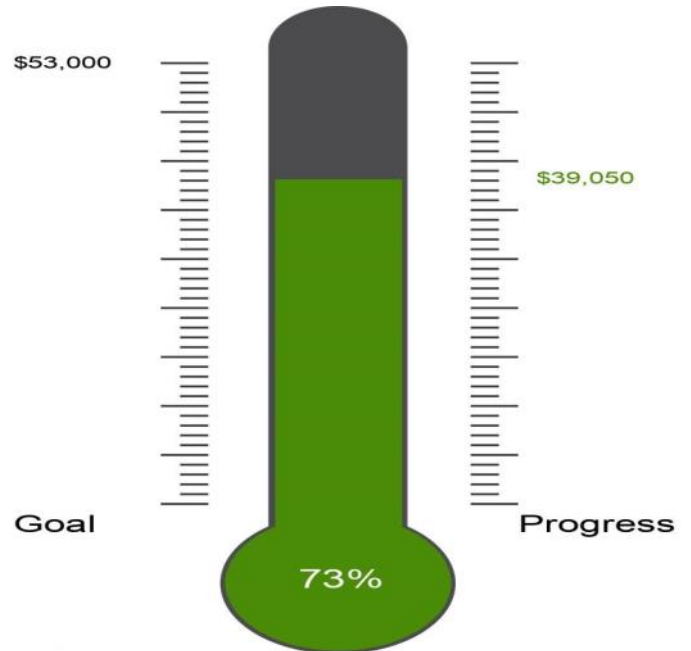
