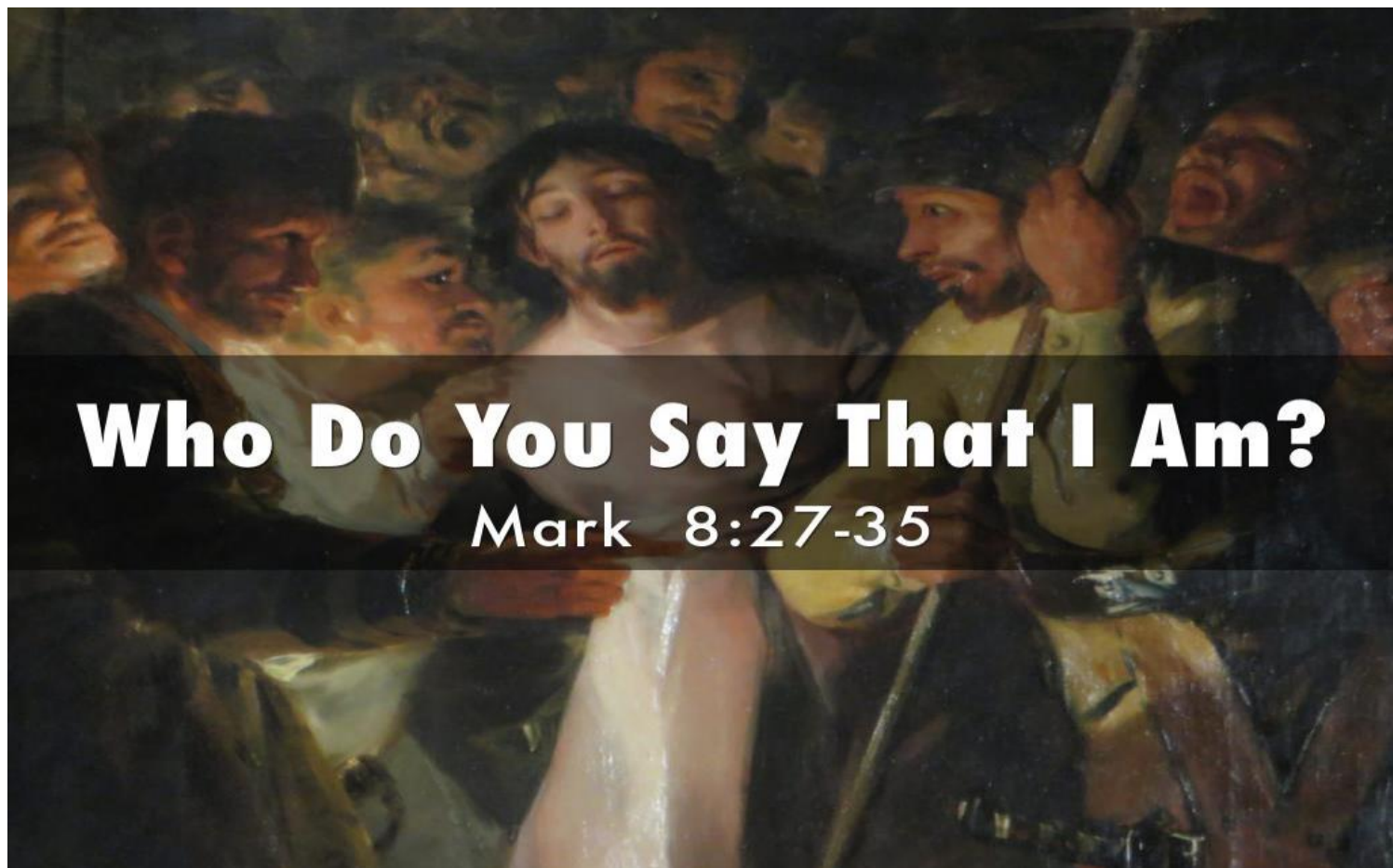

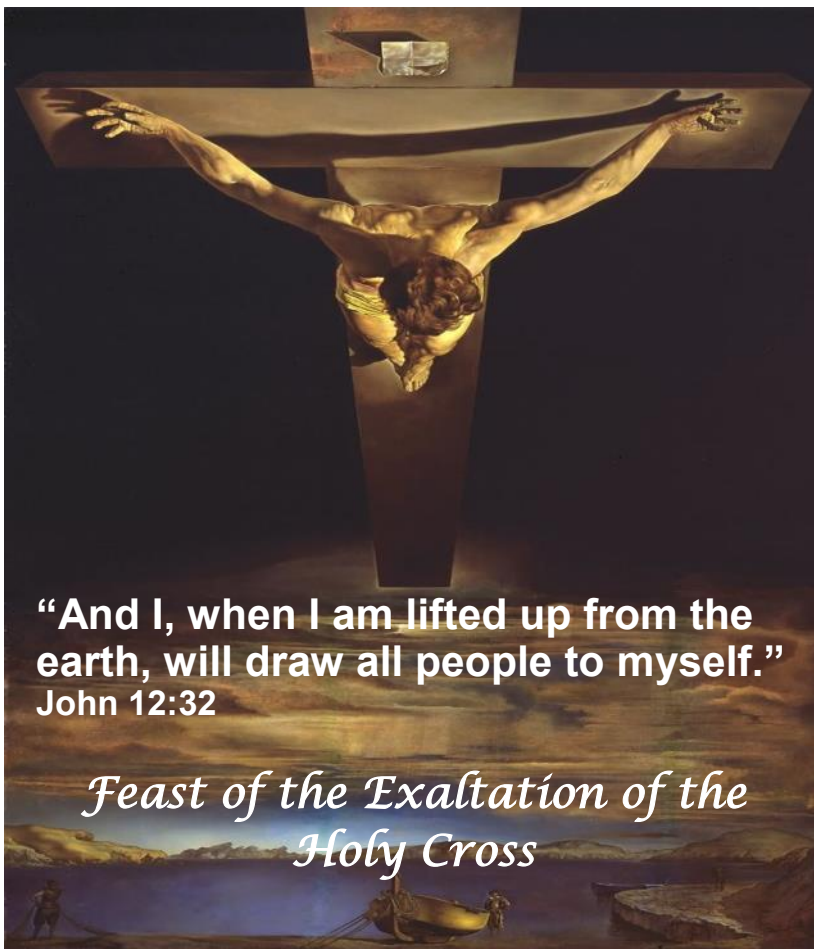

Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross



The second collection on September 11 & 12 is for the Seminarian Fund. We still need to continue to foster vocations in our diocese and continue to support the young men who are in the seminary. One way to show our support is to continue praying for them and their vocations. Another and more temporal way to support is through giving. Each year the cost of educating each of these students is approximately \$35,000. Please be generous!

Archbishop José H. Gomez of Los Angeles, president of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), called for a collection to aid the people of Haiti after an Earthquake destroyed much in the country, and then was followed by a tropical storm that added to the misery. That collection is scheduled on September 25/26. That call states: “The funds collected for this special appeal will be used to support the pastoral and reconstruction needs of the Church as well as the efforts of Catholic Relief Services and/or Catholic Charities USA, the official relief agencies of the U.S. Catholic Church, as they and their local agencies respond to immediate emergency needs and aid in long-term rebuilding and recovery efforts. The funds will be used in response to the earthquake and Tropical Storm Grace calamities in Haiti and any other disasters that occur and will be distributed where they are most needed. However, if such purposes become unnecessary, impractical, or impossible to fill, USCCB may use such contributions for other emergency disaster relief where it is most needed as determined by the Committee on National Collections using its emergency response protocol.” For more information on the Catholic Church’s work in Haiti, please visit: <http://www.usccb.org/committees/church-latin-america> and www.crs.org/our-work-overseas/where-we-work/haiti.
