Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

We have all read or heard about, by now, the unfolding conflict and devastation caused by Russian military operations in Ukraine. The photos and videos we witness show a nation beset by loss and violence, with people forced into cramped conditions and other countries as shelter from weapons of war and bombed buildings. Our thoughts and our prayers remain with the Ukrainian people at this time.

Many people have asked about ways to help support the people of Ukraine, apart from the thoughts and prayers we offer for peace and revitalization. Hence, together with the priests in the Diocese, I ask you to take up a special second collection on this Palm Sunday to provide for the needs of God's people who are suffering in Ukraine or in other places as refugees of the conflict. These funds will be sent to Catholic Relief Services.

Catholic Relief Services will directly provide for the people of Ukraine with deployments of volunteers and shipments of aide in the regions most affected. With so many people displaced from housing largely destroyed by the invading force, there will be many refugees with many needs who will be helped with our support. Food, water, shelter, clothing, and other comforts we have come to take for granted will have to be provided for on a large scale. Together with other dioceses in the United States, we will provide for these needs and seek an end to the violence occurring at the hands of Russia.

In this collection, you join with Catholics around the world to stand in solidarity with Ukraine and its refugees. Pope Francis encourages us to pray and fast as a means of peace along with our contributions. If you have not already done so, please consider supporting the efforts to end the suffering in Ukraine as we begin Holy Week where we remember the suffering of our Lord.

Please send the funds received in this second collection to the Diocese no later than April 30<sup>th</sup>.
