Introduction to the Mass #5 - The Bible in the Mass

"Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life." John 6:68 NIV

Nearly every part of the Mass is Biblical—indeed if you were to take every Bible reference out of the Mass, it would only last about 30 seconds. Indeed, the word 'Testament' (i.e., Old/New Testament) and the word 'Covenant' are synonyms. They are translations of the same word in both Hebrew (בְּרִית) and Greek (διαθήκη). Christ established the New Covenant in the "Paschal Mystery," and the Mass makes us present to that New Covenant. So, in a way, the Mass is the Bible in ritual form. Have you ever done "Lectio Divina" (a prayerful reading of the Bible)? What are some parts of the Mass that you recognize in the Bible?
