



From Bishop Mueggenborg:
Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Saint John Paul II founded the AMS in 1985 to offer the entire complement of pastoral ministries of the Catholic Church to people serving in the United States Armed Forces. The mission of the Archdiocese is "Serving Those Who Serve," by offering pastoral care and services to Catholics serving in the U.S. Armed Forces, students at U.S. Military Academies, patients at any of the 153 Department of Veterans Affairs' Medical Centers in the United States, Puerto Rico, and Guam, employees of the federal government working outside of U.S. borders, and their families, within the boundaries of other Catholic dioceses like Reno. Members of our own diocese are included in this. While the government pays for the salaries and retirement benefits of military chaplains, neither the military nor the government provides financing to the AMS for the support of programs and activities essential to the mission and ministry of its mission, such as Vocations, Evangelization, and Sacramental Records, Veterans Affairs, Tribunal, and catechesis. The AMS does not have any parishes or parish registries, unlike a traditional diocese. The AMS has no weekly collections and is entirely funded by the kindness of private donors. Please consider how you can join in prayer and sacrifice for the Universal Church and support the important missionary programs and needs across the world offered through a sister diocese. A special 2nd collection will be taken up this weekend.

Opening Rites #8 – The Collect

Trust in Him at all times, O people; pour out your hearts before Him. God is our refuge. Psalm 62:8

The final action of the Introductory Rites is the Collect. The priest will begin the prayer by saying, "Let us pray," which is meant to be more of a command than just an introduction—in the silence following this invitation, each individual should be offering up their prayers in the silence of their hearts. After a few moments, the priest will say a prayer that gathers together or 'collects' all of the diverse petitions we just offered to God in our hearts. This prayer then becomes one prayer that is offered on behalf of all. Usually, there is some specific intention that is included, like the sanctification of the Church or an outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon those gathered, which gives a definite trajectory to the Mass itself.
