The Story of the Most Holy Name of the Blessed Virgin Mary

This feast is a counterpart to the Feast of the Holy Name of Jesus; both have the possibility of uniting people easily divided on other matters. The feast of the Most Holy Name of Mary began in Spain in 1513 and in 1671 was extended to all of Spain and the Kingdom of Naples. In 1683, John Sobieski, king of Poland, brought an army to the outskirts of Vienna to stop the advance of Muslim armies loyal to Mohammed IV of Constantinople. After Sobieski entrusted himself to the Blessed Virgin Mary, he and his soldiers thoroughly defeated the Muslims. Pope Innocent XI extended this feast to the entire Church. Reflection - Mary always points us to God, reminding us of God's infinite goodness. She helps us to open our hearts to God's ways, wherever those may lead us. Honored under the title "Queen of Peace," Mary encourages us to cooperate with Jesus in building a peace based on justice, a peace that respects the fundamental human rights of all peoples.

Communion Rites #5 - Prayer before Communion

"Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the living God, who, by the will of the Father and the work of the Holy Spirit, through your Death gave life to the world, free me by this, your most holy Body and Blood, from all my sins and from every evil; keep me always faithful to your commandments, and never let me be parted from you." Excerpt from the Roman Missal

You might notice that immediately after the 'Lamb of God' the priest will say a quiet prayer under his breath and then genuflect. This is the second and last time the priest will pray directly to Jesus, and it is the priest's opportunity to prepare himself for receiving Christ in the Eucharist. And so he prays for Jesus' mercy and blessing, and then genuflects in adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. But while the priest does this, we, the laity, are to do the same (c.f. GIRM 84). And so this brief period of silence invites us to ask for Jesus' mercy and blessing in the silence of our own hearts. How do you pray to Jesus during the Mass?
