

Communion Rites #4 - The Fraction Rite

"Then the two recounted what had taken place on the way and how he was made known to them in the breaking of the bread."

Luke 24:35 NAB

During the Lamb of God, the priest will break the principle host. This has a twofold significance. Primarily, it is a symbol of Christ's body broken for us at His Crucifixion, entering into our broken humanity. Paradoxically, however, it is also a symbol of our unity-that the body of Christ broken is shared by the whole Church uniting it together in Christ Jesus. We receive the one bread so become one in Christ (c.f. 1 Corinthians 10:17). How does Christ unite you to those around you? How do you see Christ's Crucifixion in the Mass?
