Jesus is like a householder who has gone abroad. He has left his servants - that is, you and me - in charge of his affairs, each one with their own task. What is my task, my role in this world? "Stay awake because you do not know when the master will come back - "stay awake." How do we do that? Very simply. We keep in touch with those around us by each day doing our best to live lives of love, of compassion, of forgiveness, of honesty and integrity. We keep in touch with our God through lives of prayer. And the simplest and deepest prayer is to be aware of the active presence of God permeating every single moment of every single day. "O Lord, help to recognize you and respond to you in love through every person and every experience of this day."

In Luke 1:28 the angel Gabriel, speaking on God's behalf, addresses Mary as "full of grace" or "highly favored". In that context, this phrase means that Mary is receiving all the special divine help necessary for the task ahead. However, the Church grows in understanding with the help of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit led the Church, especially nontheologians, to the insight that Mary had to be the most perfect work of God next to the Incarnation. Or rather, Mary's intimate association with the Incarnation called for the special involvement of God in Mary's whole life. The logic of piety helped God's people to believe that Mary was full of grace and free of sin from the first moment of her existence. Moreover, this great privilege of Mary is the highlight of all that God has done in Jesus. Rightly understood, the incomparable holiness of Mary shows forth the incomparable goodness of God.

Special Second Collection: Next Weekend

Across the United States, hundreds of religious communities— Priests, Brothers, Sisters, and Nuns-lack financial resources to meet the retirement and healthcare needs of aging members. Many elderly religious spent their youth working for small stipends, with little for retirement savings. Simultaneously, the decrease in religious vocations means that few religious are able to serve in compensated ministry. Today, retired religious outnumber wage-earners by three to one. The Retirement Fund for Religious (RFR) attempts to provide for those religious who gave their lives to the church. Most donations to the RFR are distributed as Direct Care Assistance, going to individual religious for immediate eldercare needs or saved for long-term expenses. Nearly 25,000 elderly sisters, brothers, and religious order priests benefit annually from this fund. Roughly 95 percent of the RFR budget aides senior religious. The remainder is used for administration of the funds and promotion of the nationwide RFR appeal. Donating to this fund is a great way to help the growing number of elderly religious who due their service to God were unable to save for their retirement.
