This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family. Though he was conceived of a virgin, Jesus nevertheless lived as a son in a human family -- a family which points the way for the rest of us. The family is the sanctuary of life. There can be no life without family, and there can be no family without life. The family, above all, is where life is to be welcomed, no matter how fragile or inconvenient it may be. One of the many reasons why abortion is the pre-eminent issue is because, as St. John Paul II pointed out in "The Gospel of Life," these crimes are committed by one family member upon another. May the Holy Family lead us to a Culture of Life!





Way back in 431, there was a bitter controversy among theologians over the role of Mary in the Catholic Church. They debated the question: Who is Mary in God's plan? In the end, the bishops declared that Mary is really the mother of Jesus and Jesus is really God. So it must be said that Mary is the Mother of God. The oldest Christian greeting of Mary was proclaimed when Mary's relative Elizabeth called her "Mother of my Lord." When Elizabeth welcomed Mary, she recognized both the great privilege God had given Mary and Mary's great faith in accepting it. For centuries, Mary has been praised because she believed. She is Mother of God because of her faith in God. The Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, celebrates Mary's faith and trust in God alone. The Church wants us to imitate her faith.

Last weekend's collection was \$18,440.12. For Christmas, we received \$47,980.12. To say we are appreciative is an understatement. Also, to everyone who donated to #iGiveCatholic, thank you! Because of your generosity, we made (and surpassed) our goal and brought in \$22,475.45. And as an added bonus, today (12/27) we had our brand new generator installed. We did make our 2023 assessment for CSA, but do not have the exact numbers just yet. God has blessed this church with generous people in the area of stewardship, and their prayers and talents. The work we do here at OLT could not happen without the consistent and bountiful gifts and again, thank you for being a blessing with your giving! May God reward you for your kindness! A gentle reminder that the new Sunday morning mass time is at 10am. This change is for the winter only and will end on Palm Sunday, March 24th. New Year's Day Mass is Monday, January 1 at 11:30am. The church and office are closed Friday, December 29th and Monday, January 1st.

Our diocese will take up the Collection for the Church in Latin America. For more than 50 years, this collection has given Catholics in the United States an opportunity to share faith in unity with our brothers and sisters in Christ throughout Latin America and the Caribbean islands. The work of evangelization is carried out by Christians who meet people where they are-not only in a geographical sense but also in the context of culture. Though the Gospel is unchanging, we have many ways to make it relevant to people of all cultural, ethnic, and linguistic backgrounds. The countries of South America have diverse populations from Indigenous, African, European, and Asian ancestries, all with different cultural experiences. By welcoming and understanding people from so many backgrounds, the Church grows and continues its mission of making disciples of all peoples. In Brazil, the Brazilian Bishops' Conference organized visits and meetings to engage Afro-Brazilian Catholic leaders in discussing a variety of themes, including social pastoral ministry and the vision of Pope Francis. In Peru, missionaries working in the Peruvian Amazon bring the Gospel to the Ashaninka and Matsigenka communities of about 60,000 people. Such encounters and engagement with the peoples of South America are made possible when Catholics in our diocese are generous to the Collection for the Church in Latin America. Your participation in the collection truly becomes a way to share your faith and support evangelization efforts among all peoples. After the Mass, we also have an obligation to proclaim the Gospel to all peoples. However, we do not have to go far off lands to do thismany people in our communities may have had a tangential encounter with the Gospel, such that they might have heard the name of the Savior, but do not understand its significance. Evangelization in this situation becomes very difficult, because people will have a distorted or superficial concept of what it means to be Catholic and that can be a barrier to conversion. And so now more than ever there is the need to proclaim the Gospel clearly with both our words and our actions. Is there someone in your life who has not yet had an encounter with Jesus? How might you bring the Gospel to those in your life?

This marks our 31st year of helping our local families in California and Nevada.
