In the Gospel according to John, we find Jesus engaged in a profound conversation with Nicodemus, a Pharisee and ruler of the Jews. In this encounter, Jesus speaks of the necessity of being born again, of water and the Spirit, to enter the kingdom of God. He refers to an event from the Israelites' history, when Moses lifted up the bronze serpent in the wilderness, foreshadowing His own lifting up on the cross. Jesus reveals that God's love for the world is so great that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. However, He also exposes the reality that those who reject Him stand condemned already because they prefer darkness over light.



## Chrism Mass Service

"For behold, the winter is past; the rain is over and gone. The flowers appear on the earth, the time of singing has come, and the voice of the turtledove is heard in our land. " -Song of Solomon 2:11-12

Spring (9 days away, yay!) is a beautiful time of year when the winter weather subsides, and the flowers begin to bloom. Because of this, spring is often associated with hope and rebirth-two major aspects of the resurrection of Christ. As we shake off that winter chill, consider starting a new positive habit or recommitting to our prayer life. And remember to SPRING AHEAD, Sunday, March 10, **DAYLIGHT SAVINGS time begins.** 

On March 21st at Saint Rose of Lima, Bishop Mueggenborg will celebrate the annual Chrism Mass! The Chrism Mass centers around the blessing of the three Holy Oils that will be used in Baptism, Confirmation, Anointing of the Sick, and Holy Orders for the following year. After the blessing of the Holy Oils, they will be distributed to all of our Catholic Parishes in the Diocese. Additionally, the Priests of the Diocese - in the presence of the Bishop - renew their promise of priestly ministry. This is a unique Mass in the Church's liturgical calendar and is a great way to prepare for Holy Week. Please join us for the Chrism Mass at 5:30PM at Saint Rose of Lima on March 21st.




