

For all the austerity of his life, John spoke to people in words they could grasp. It was his austerity that drew people's respect and trust. Here was a man who cared nothing for comfort, money or fame, who could not be bought, and who could speak the truth without fear. Preparing the way for the Messiah is not simply a matter of belonging to the Jewish nation, John insists, but comes about through repentance, through changing the way one thinks and changing one's lifestyle. John gives some practical examples. People should share clothing and food with those who have none as basic expressions of faith. To tax collectors he says, "Collect no more than the amount prescribed for you." Soldiers also ask him, "And we, what should we do?" John replies, "Do not extort money from anyone with threats or false accusations and be satisfied with your wages." What does my lifestyle say about my faith in Christ? Do I hoard or share what I have with others, especially those who are poor and on the margins of society?

Can you believe it is already the third week of Advent? With Christmas approaching, we can often get caught up in the business and stress that comes with the holiday season. With so much going on around us, it is important that we remain focused on the <u>real meaning</u> of Christmas. The third week in Advent is traditionally called *Gaudete Sunday*, which is Latin for "<u>rejoice</u>." This is a familiar word for Christians, but are we familiar with the true meaning? To rejoice in something is more than just to have a happy disposition. It is a supernatural joy, one that is given to us in the spirit. As Paul says, *Rejoice in the Lord always*; again *I will say*, *rejoice*. Let your reasonableness be known to everyone. The Lord is at hand; <u>do not be anxious about anything</u>, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will <u>guard your hearts</u> and your minds in Christ Jesus. God does not just want us to be of good cheer this Christmas season but wants us to rejoice in the gift he has given us. He encourages us <u>not be afraid</u>, but take refuge in his <u>promise</u>, just as the baby John the Baptist: For behold, when the sound of your greeting came to my ears, the baby in my womb leaped for joy. Let us follow in John's footsteps as he prepares the way of the Lord!


